

- *Price, quality, visual impact;
- *Environmental impact, public health and safety;
- *Distribution of costs and benefits, procedures.

INDIVIDUAL FACTORS

- *Values;
- *Place-attachment, place-identity;
- *Trust in responsible parties.

PERCEIVED COSTS AND BENEFITS:

- Individual;
- Collective;
- Distributional and procedural justice.


Strong egoistic values








Strong biospheric values






